

Memorandum Of Understanding Declaration of Graz 2025

PREAMBLE

The undersigned parties, representing a group of European Chips Competence Centres,

- Recognising the strategic importance of semiconductors and microelectronics for Europe's technological sovereignty, economic resilience, and competitiveness in the global digital economy;
- Acknowledging the objectives of the European Chips Act and the "Chips for Europe Initiative" to strengthen Europe's capacity in semiconductor research, development, design, and production;
- Emphasising the need for close cooperation, knowledge exchange, and shared access to infrastructure, in order to accelerate innovation and foster a robust European semiconductor ecosystem;
- Affirming their commitment to openness, transparency, and non-discrimination, ensuring that SMEs, start-ups, academia, and industry at large benefit from the services of the Competence Centres;
- Determining to contribute to education, training, and skills development in order to strengthen Europe's workforce and attract talent to the semiconductor sector;
- Striving to enhance Europe's visibility, capacity for innovation, and ability to lead in emerging technologies such as
 - o Thin film Technologies, Advanced Materials, Quantum & Photonics;
 - o please PARTNERS add your core fields of expertise

hereby express their shared intention to cooperate within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding, to foster collaboration across borders, and to jointly contribute to Europe's sustainable semiconductor ecosystem.

PURPOSE:

The Parties agree to put their best efforts to achieve the following objectives:

- Avoiding fragmentation and fostering synergies
 The aCCCess Consortium will strive to coordinate all activities, acting as a central platform for networking, transparency, and governance. Together, they will strive to develop Europe-wide roadmaps, harmonize standards, and establish regular exchange formats to prevent duplication and build a coherent European semiconductor ecosystem.
- Ensuring fair and non-discriminatory access
 The centres will strive for open access under the conditions given by their individual funding contracts to infrastructure, expertise, and funding for all relevant stakeholders, particularly SMEs and start-ups.
- Maximizing efficiency and impact of resources
 Supported by the aCCCess Consortium, the centres will implement common practices for monitoring, evaluation, and best-practices sharing to ensure effective use of funding and infrastructure.
- Promoting skills development and training across Europe



In close cooperation with the aCCCess Consortium, the centres will coordinate educational and qualification programs, facilitate talent mobility across Europe, and actively address the semiconductor skills gap.

- Strengthening Europe's strategic independence
 With the involvement of the aCCCess Consortium, the centres will strive to develop regional and European value chains, pilot facilities, and key technologies to enhance Europe's resilience in the semiconductor sector.
- Enhancing trust and visibility
 The aCCCess Consortium will support the centres in transparent communication, reporting on achievements, and conducting outreach initiatives to increase the attractiveness and recognition of the European semiconductor sector.

EXCLUSIVITY:

The Parties do not grant exclusivity to each other on the basis of this MoU.

MoU NON-BINDING:

The Parties acknowledge that this MoU is of a non-binding nature, and that it does not create any legal or financial obligations for or between Parties whatsoever. It is recognised that nothing in this MoU authorises or empowers any of the Parties to speak or act on behalf of the other Parties.

EXPENSES:

Each Party will bear its own costs and expenses related to the actions or transactions contemplated by this MoU.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION:

This MoU is entered into as of the date it is signed by the later Party to sign ('Effective Date'). Each Party shall have the right to terminate this MoU in writing. This MoU will terminate automatically by 31st December 2028. No Party shall have any obligation or liability on any account whatsoever to the other Party.

CHANGES AND AMENDMENS:

Changes and amendments to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by authorised representatives of the Parties.



Through this declaration, the Competence Centres, together with the aCCCess Consortium, reaffirm their commitment to building a strong, open, and future-oriented semiconductor ecosystem in Europe, thereby contributing significantly to Europe's technological sovereignty and global competitiveness.
